3	1-2	\$60,000 3 companies each at the maximum allowed per company, must apply the rule of 10 shares minimum
4	3-4	\$80,000 4 companies each at the maximum allowed per company must apply the rule of 10 shares minimum
6	6	\$100,000 4 compaies each at the maximum allowed per company and 2 @ the minimum investment per company must apply the rule of 10 shares minimum
7	7-8	\$100,000 permutation (for example 3 companies @ the maxmum investment per company and 4 companies @ must apply the rule of 10 shares minimum
8	9-10	\$100,000 permutation (for example 2 companies @ the maxmum investment per company and 6 companies @ the minimum, must apply the rule of 10 shares minimum
10	11-12	\$100,000 permutation (for example 10 companies @ the maxmum investment per company must apply the rule of 10 shares minimum
